## **Waukesha State bank to Fox & Hounds Restaurant**

- 1) Capital Drive West to Brookfield Road – Turn Right – North
- 2) Brookfield Road North to Lisbon Road – Turn Left – West
- 3) Lisbon Road West to Waukesha Ave. – Turn Right – North
- 4) Waukesha Ave. North to Clover Drive – Turn Left - West
- 5) Clover Drive West to Maple Ave. - Turn Right - North
- 6) Maple Ave. North to Plainview Road – Turn Left – West
- 7) Plainview Road West to Hillside Road – Turn Right – North
- 8) Hillside Road North to Monches Road - Turn Right – East
- 9) Monches Road East changes to Scenic Road East and curves to the North
- 10) Continue on Scenic Road North to Elmwood Road – Turn Left - West
- 11) Elmwood Road West to HWY 164 – Turn Right – North
- 12) HWY 164 North to Hubertus Road – Turn Left - West
- 13) Hubertus Road West to Friess Lake Road - Right at Y intersection - North
- 14) Friess Lake Road North to Fox & Hounds Restaurant on Right

## **Fox & Hounds Restaurant to Holy Hill Church**

- 1) Turn Left from Fox & Hounds Restaurant to Friess Lake Road South
- 2) At first intersection – Turn Right on Hogsback Road (No Road Sign)
- 3) Hogsback Road West curving North St Augustine Road -Bear Right
- 4) St Augustine Road North to HWY 167 - Turn Left – West
- 5) HWY 167 West to Holy Hill Entrance on Left.

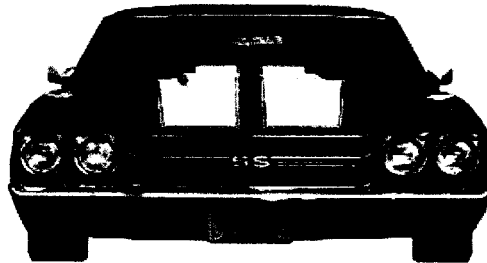
